- Vote taken to take on 1 size extra in all 4 garment types (after an awful ot of debate)
- Kit Subsidy Decision taken to no longer subsidise kit for adults, however Juniors (under 18s) to be provided with a free jersey if required. The junior needs to be active with the club on a regular basis rather than have completed a regular number of events. If junior requires more than one top (due to damage/Growth



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etc) this will be provided at discretion of Fran/committee
