## KCC Committee Meeting 21st August 2023

**Apologies** – Graham Millar

**Sportive** – Paul Z gave an update on progress of organising sportive. No Lead yet appointed, but there are however a number of key individuals confirmed with enough people to organise. Trevor, Mark and Piper all confirmed to support the tech aspects, whilst Kathryn will support coordinating volunteering, although a lead for this is still required

- A series of Sportive meetings have been set up.
- Bandrum will again sponsor the event
- A cheque for total donations raised from the 2023 Sportive was presented to CHAS

**Finance** — Neil in his capacity as treasurer provided an update on club funds, including projected income and Budget

**Club kit update** (Fran) – good few boxes of old kit still for sale, mainly in odd sizes – The recent order of club kit from Endura (other than caps) has now been delivered. Caps due in coming weeks due to issues at Endura's end

**IT**— Graham updated — Committee agreed to cover costs for TurboSMTP used for both the KCC & Sportive Websites

**KCC visit to Chris Hoy velodrome** – Fran looking into potentially organising a day at the velodrome in Glasgow. Issues are securing a suitable date. General feeling amongst committee member is that this would prove popular with members, however we would need to gain commitment from a minimum number of participants, ideally 20-30 – potential to organise via Spond and request small deposit from interested members.

**GP / FCA** – need volunteers for GP de gentlemen in September – Jane to put request on Spond for volunteers

**First aid** — Jane provided update on first aid course - still to communicate to the member that raised it — if 8 members that haven't done a course, already are interested then the Club will organise. If not but members wish to attend a course then if they find and book one themselves the club will reimburse them. Anyone receiving a training course paid for by the club is expected to be a regular club rider, either in a Ride leader, sat/sun ride member, or regular club volunteer

**Awards night** — Rather than an official awards night with speaker it is proposed that it is replaced by a social meet and ride at fife cycle park end of October — Jane and Maggie to organise. This will involve presentation of trophies, cakes and track time, potentially with some coaching. There could be further opportunity for a more informal Christmas night out to be organised at a later date
