It is impossible to tell how many new persons will turn up for this ride and at what level of fitness and riding ability they will bring. Existing members who attend must be prepared to split into 3 or possibly even 4 groups so that any new member can ride at a pace they find suitable.

If more than 10 persons turn up then the start should be staggered or split to 3 – 5 mins intervals so that no too large a peloton forms of the road.

Concern was raised about the clubs position if there was an accident or incident to one of the riders.

It was agreed John M should contact Scottish Cycling for their advice.

## Club Kit

There was again a lot of discussion regarding finalisation of club kit.

The following are the majority of main points:-

- Tony Brotherton has been co-opted / agreed to be Kit coordinator.
- John M to finalise all details with Carvalho.
- Tony B may purchase an extra £500 worth of kit so that new members will not be delayed in purchasing club kit. (appreciated by KCC and all present)
- The design would generally be as the design recently submitted by Carvalho with some minor alterations required.
- Kinross CC on collars.
- Kinross taken out so that it does not duplicate with the logo leaving Cycling Club which can now be in line beneath the logo.
- Speed waves to be added to logo.
- Logo to have solid wheels with increased thickness of CC within them.
- **Final colours are to be Yellow PMS 116 and purple PMS 2755.**
- John M to produce order form for members with restricted list of garments...Short & long sleeved jersey, arm warmers, med weight bib shorts, fingerless mitts.
- Full payment to accompany order forms or no kit.
- Deadline for orders set by Tony B as Friday 21<sup>st</sup> Aug.
- Cost to members would be not be subsidised neither would the club seek to make profit.
- Costs of postage and packaging and any exchange rate fluctuations or money transfer charges would be bourn by the KCC.
- Samples we tried on for size.
- Order form to include sizing chart.
- Choice of bold fonts to be given from Carvalho.

## **Sponsorship.**

Although sponsorship was not openly discussed John M had met with Roddy P and John McKay respectively. It was decided not to have sponsorship for a number of reasons.

Including:-

1. The survey of members via the poll on the yahoo site indicated that the majority were not in favour of sponsorship.
2. the time scale of obtain more sponsors style of logo and amount of funding would a relatively lengthy process where as it was felt there is a demand for immediate supply of club kit.
3. If sponsors logos were added the kit would quickly date as sponsors remove their support.
4. It was unclear as to what sponsor money is required for.
5. Money if required could possibly be source from other means.
