Update of Grants

Grants received to date:

1. Perth and Kinross **Sports Council** £200.

This was a start up grant to be used as KCC found suitable.

Split £120 already paid in 2009 which the majority was put towards the start up costs for kit production from Carvalho. The balance of £80 will be paid in 2010.

2. **2014 Communities** Grant £995 (actual spend £974.82p)

Safety signs from Impsport, Bunting and storage boxes.

This application has been completed and end of grant returns sent.

KCC can apply for this grant again in one years time.

3. **Kinross Shire** fund. Originally application for a 'small grant' for stock of kit and a 'large grant' for banners.

A combined grant was awarded for £2,340.00. Banners from POD were purchase with bases for £1,548.87p the balance of £791.13p being put into stock of club kit. Grant completion forms have been returned.
